10thAnnual Wonderland Tea Party for CHEO Mental Health Programs for Youth, June 1

Pionairs member Wendy Hubley and her family have been strongly committed to helping children suffering from mental health issues ever since their eldest son, Jamie, who suffered from depression, died by suicide in 2011. Working with community donors, and the CHEO Foundation since 2016, Wendy Hubley began her journey to help patients at CHEO (Children's Hospital of Eastern Ontario) by first redecorating and revitalizing the mental health department's patient lounge, in loving memory of her beloved son. To raise funds for these initiatives, Wendy and her committee launched the Wonderland Tea Party, an annual event

based on the theme "Alice in Wonderland Tea Party".

To date, this event has raised more than \$273,000 and CHEO is grateful that the Hubley family's unwavering support for mental health care has been matched by the generosity of family, friends, and a caring business community.

In support of Wendy's project over the years, members of the Ottawa-Gatineau District have donated in kind to the Christmas Wish List for CHEO Mental Health at the District Christmas luncheons, and have attended the Wonderland Tea Party.
